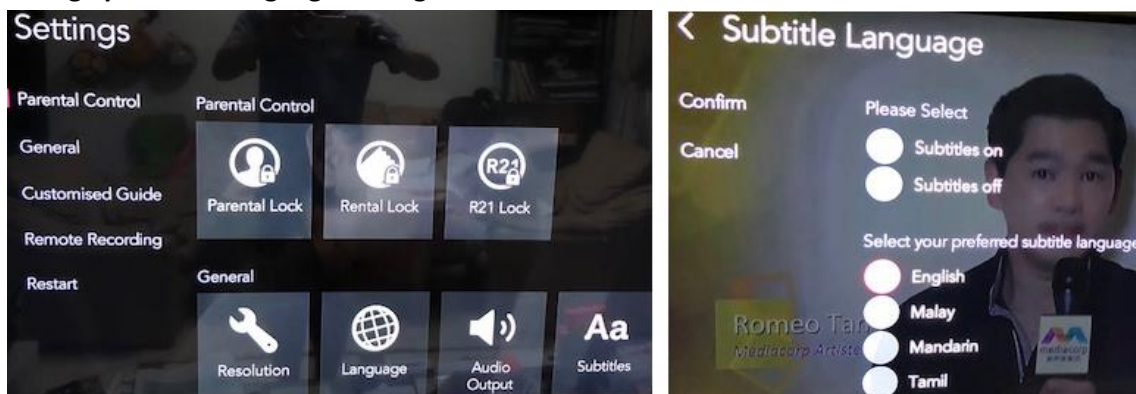


Enable/disable subtitle



- Press [Options] button
- Select <Subtitle Languages>
- Change your subtitle language

- Press [Menu] button
- Select <Settings>
- Select <Subtitles>
- Set your preferred subtitle language

- Press [*] button
- Change your subtitle language

Change preferred language setting



- Press [Menu] button
- Select <Setting>
- Select <General Setting>
- Select <Preferred Language>
- Set your preferred subtitle language

2.1 Akira 24LED45T2

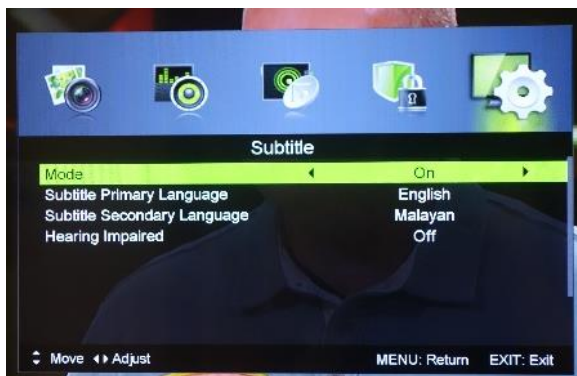


Enable/disable subtitle



- Press [Subtitle] button
- Change your subtitle language

Change preferred language setting

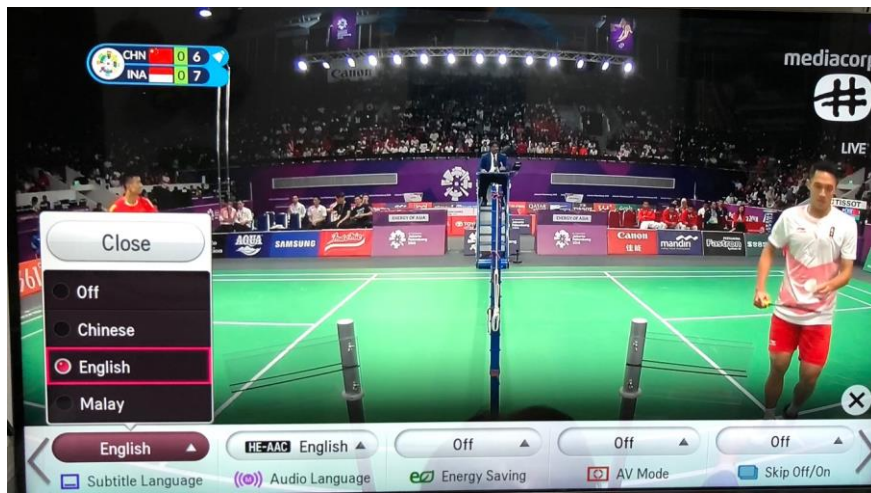


- Press [MENU] button

- Turn on the subtitle or set your preferred subtitle language

Enable/disable subtitle



- Press [SUBTITLE] button
- Change your subtitle language

Note: Some remotes label the button to access subtitle as Q-Menu

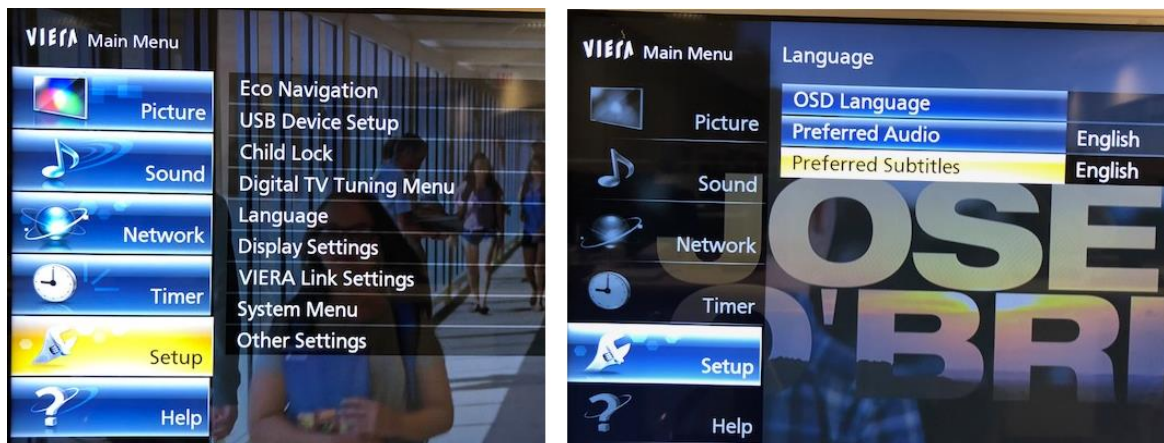


Enable/disable subtitle

Change preferred language setting

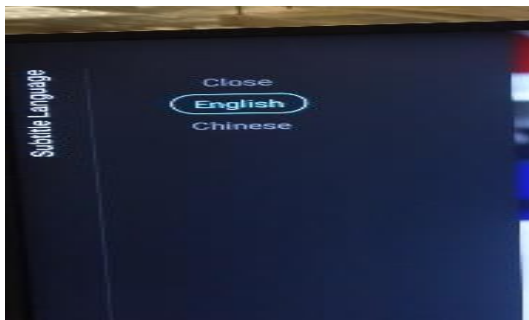

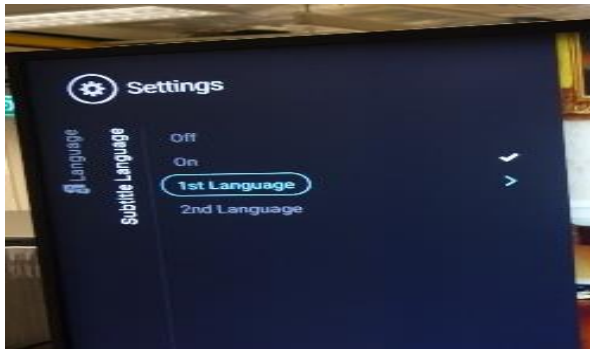

- Turn on the subtitle or set your preferred subtitle language

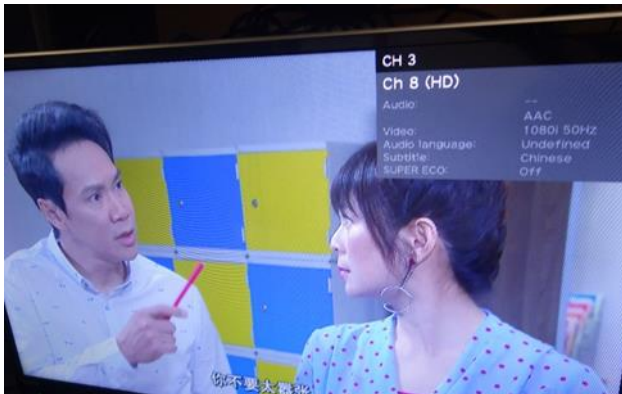

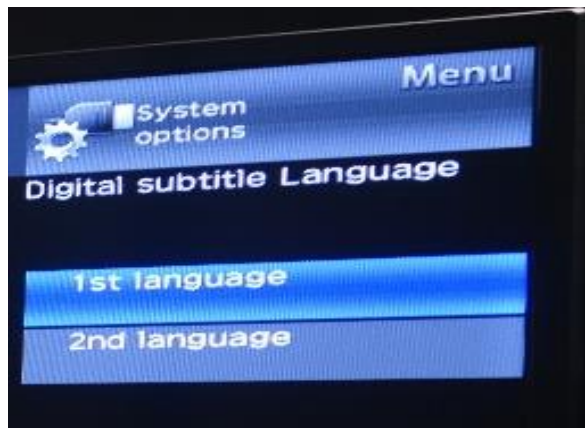

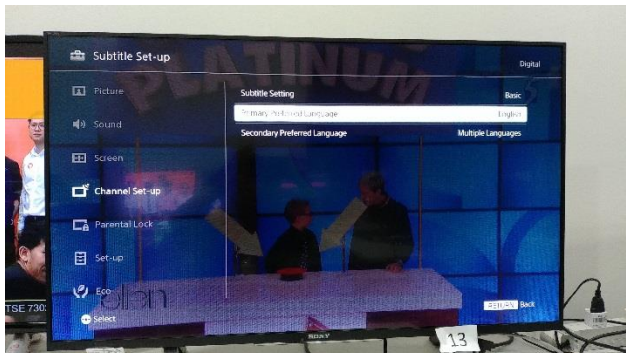

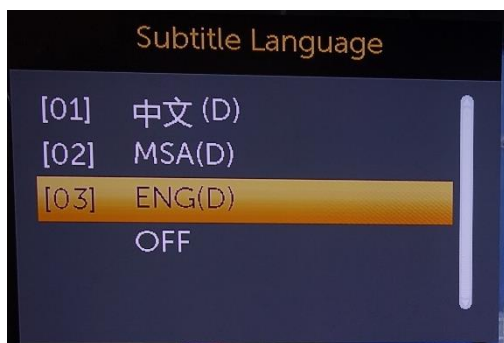

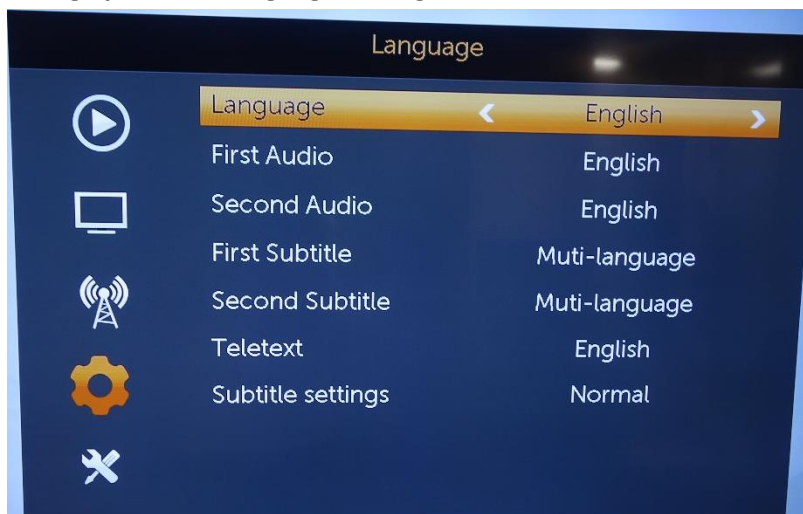

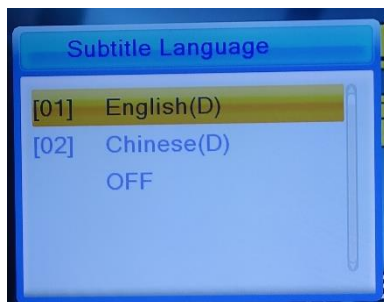

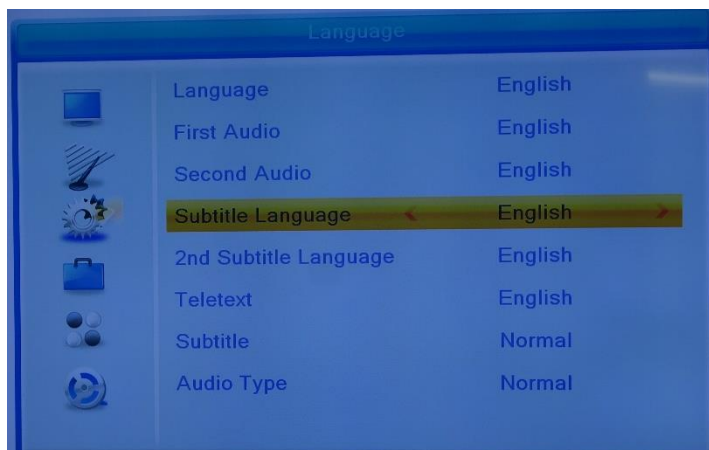

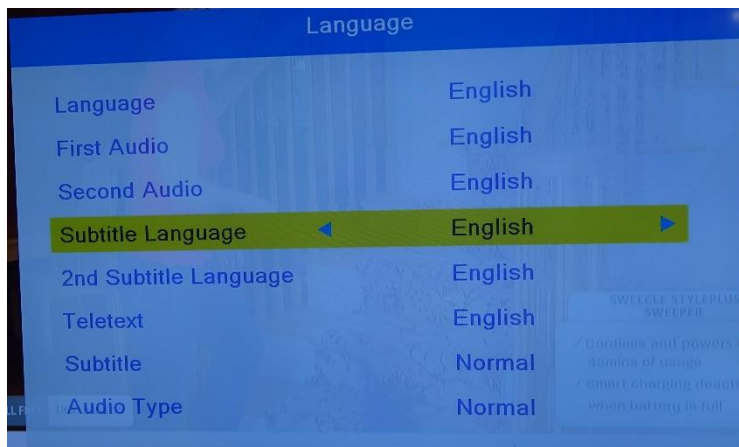

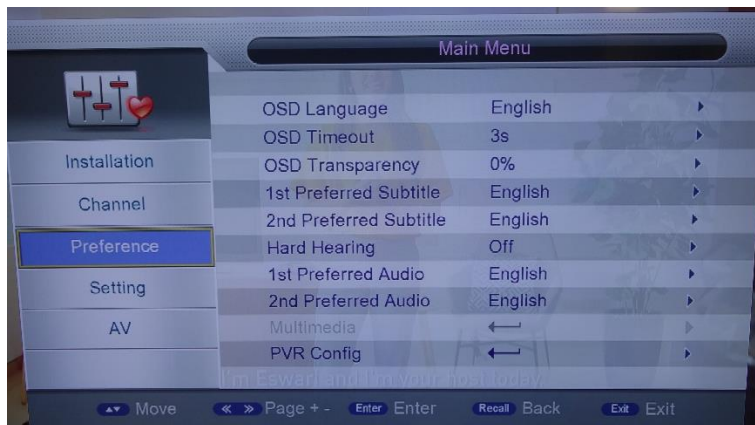

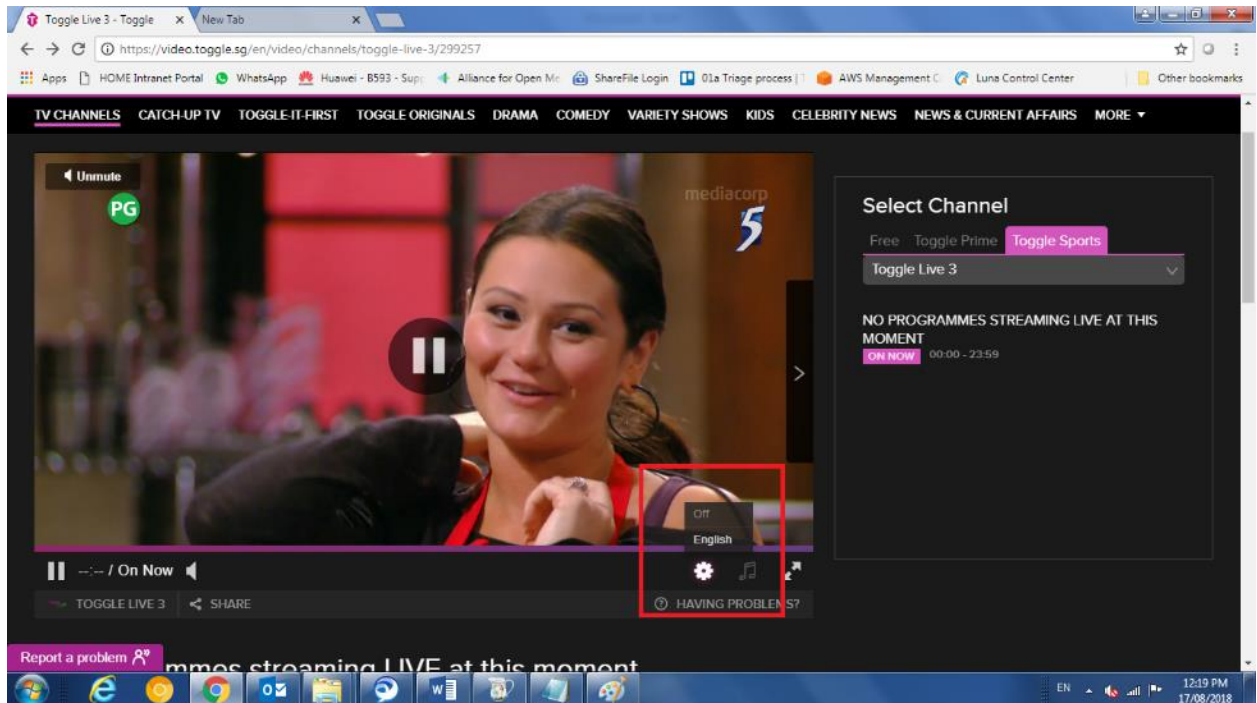

4.1 Toggle Web

To configure closed caption setting



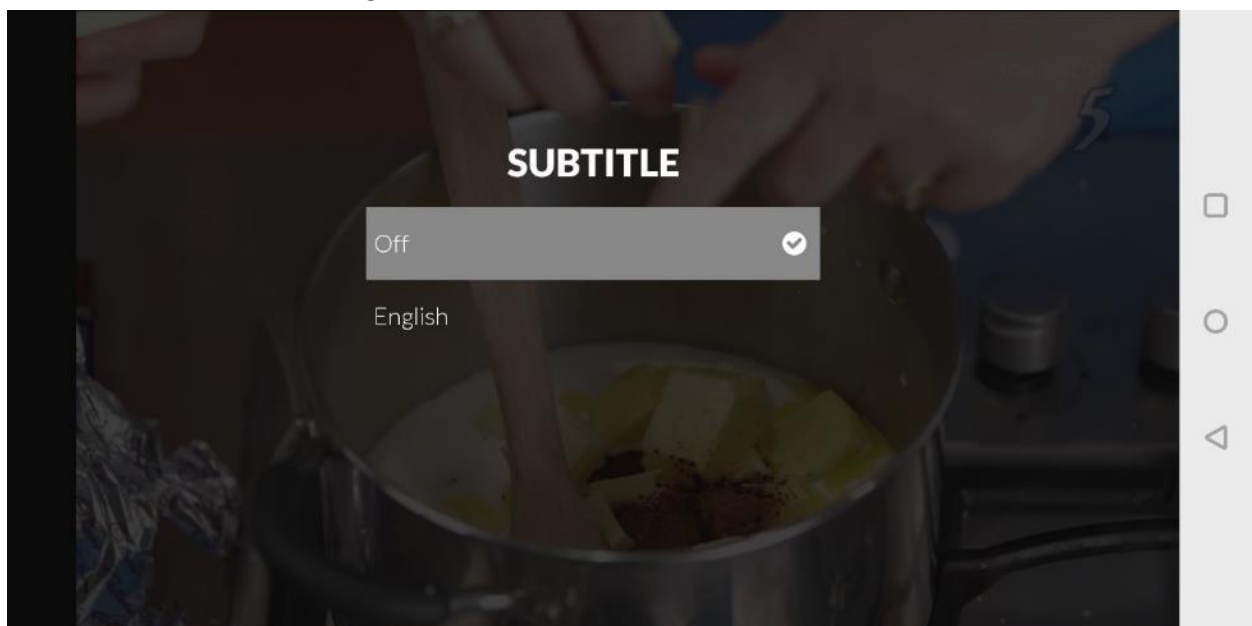
There is a gear icon on the right hand corner where user can toggle it on and off.
Default is set to Off.

4.2 Toggle Android

To configure closed caption setting



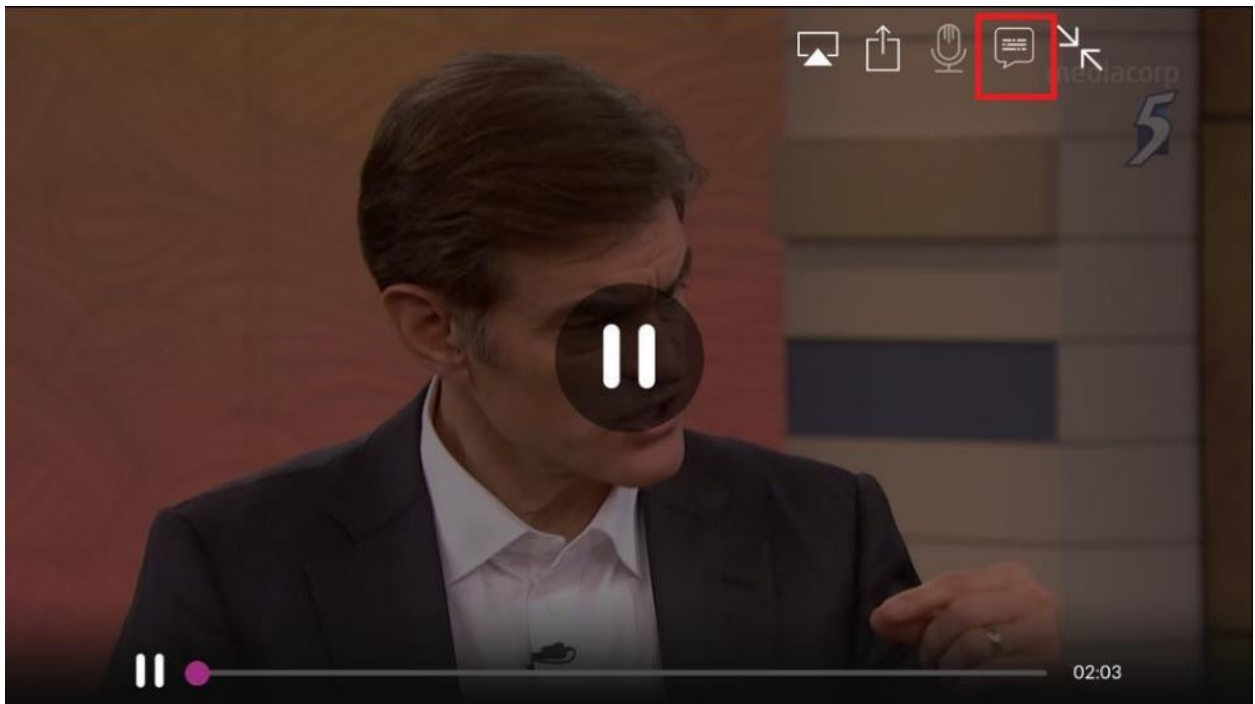
Select the icon on the lower right hand corner in the red box.



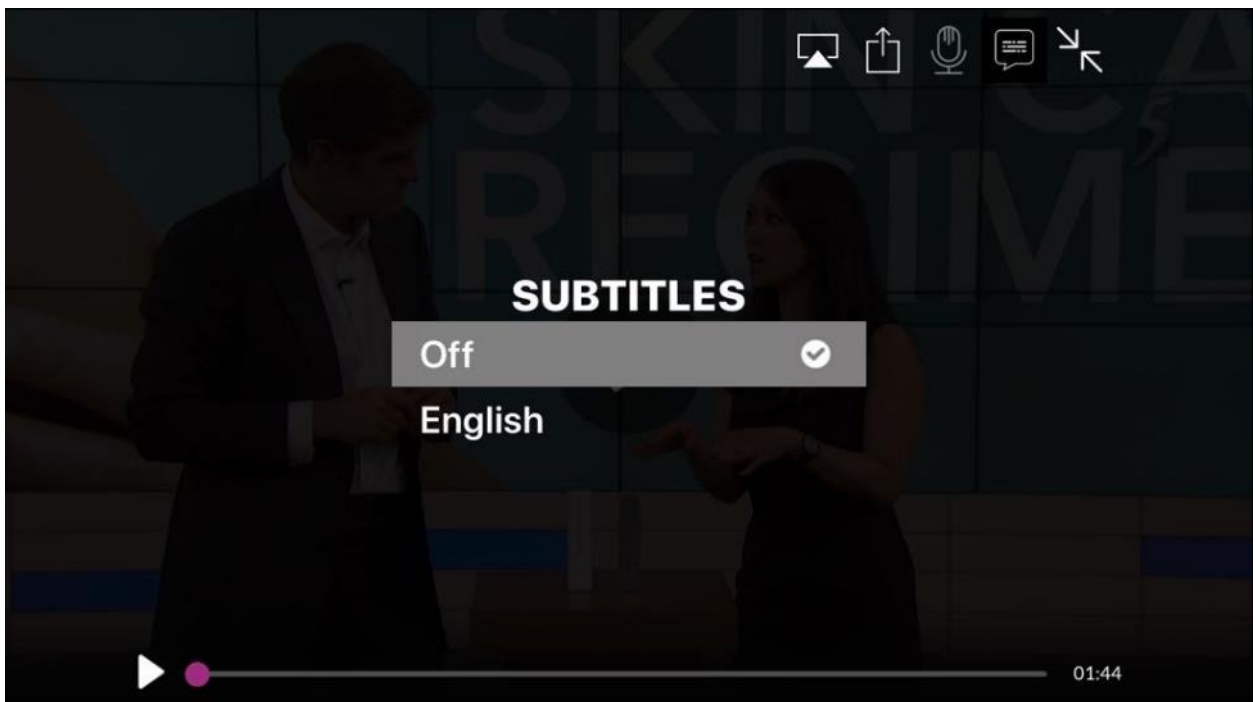
Select the language for the Closed Caption. Default is Off.
